Admission arrangements for Lord's School

Application process

Lord's School will process applications outside the normal co-ordinated admissions process. The application form can be obtained from the school. Completed applications should be sent to Lord's School.

Parents will also need to complete their local authority's common application form for their other choices of school.

Oversubscription criteria

The school will reserve the right to admit or decline any pupil with an Education, Health and Care plan which names the school depending on their needs.

Admission of children outside their normal age group

Parents may request their child is admitted outside their normal age group. Parents who wish to do so should include a request with their application, specifying the year group to which they wish their child to be admitted and why they believe it would be in their best interests. The school will make a decision on the basis of the circumstances of the case and in the child's best interests, taking into account the views of the headteacher and any information provided by the parent.
